As part of the final phase of the Forest of Avon's interpretation project along the River Avon, youngsters from Hanham Youth Centre last year created this piece of stunning environmental art.

The striking 15-metre long mural runs alongside the River Avon Trail, close by the Avon Valley Woodlands, recently designated by South Gloucestershire as a Local Nature Reserve.

Previously, the wall had been covered in slang and abstract graffiti tagging. But, working with local artist Felix Braun, the young artists took inspiration from the natural environment to design the artwork for the

wall. They also used part of their summer holidays to explore the surrounding woodlands and learn how to use green wood to make benches for the site
